Barty studied law at university before completing a master's in international law at Oslo University, where he represented Norway at the Telders International Law Moot in the Hague, winning the award for best oral argumentation.

After completing his studies, Barty worked for the Prosecutor at the UN International Residual Mechanism for Criminal Tribunals on the prosecutions of Serbian war criminals Stanisic and Simatovic. Following this, Barty worked for Global Rights Compliance LLP, advising the Office of the Prosecutor of the Ukraine on how to implement International Criminal Law standards within the national jurisdiction to prosecute Russian war crimes committed in the Crimea and Donbass.

Additionally, Barty worked as a caseworker at the Legal Centre Lesvos where he represented asylum seekers before the Greek Immigration Tribunal and lodged appeals with the ECtHR.

Barty is a Grade 1 prosecutor with particular experience representing vulnerable people.
