Jakub Kałuża is a pupil barrister in the Property, Commercial and Insolvency teams.

He commenced his pupillage at Chambers in October 2025 under the supervision of Kate Harrington (Property) and Richard Ascroft (Commercial and Insolvency).

Prior to pupillage, Jakub worked as an M&A Title Insurance Underwriter in the City of London, advising on high-value transactions and developing innovative cross-jurisdictional products. He was involved in deals worth up to £1 billion and played a key role in underwriting major UK and European real estate transactions, coordinating multiple stakeholders, including solicitors, brokers and developers.

Jakub gained advocacy experience as a Welfare Benefits Adviser at Norfolk Community Law Service, representing vulnerable clients in appeals before the First-tier Tribunal and successfully recovered over £100,000 in delayed payments.

He completed the Barrister Training Course at BPP University with Distinction, following an LLM in International Commercial and Competition Law, where he graduated in the top three of his cohort. He also holds an LLB in English Law with European Legal Systems, which included a year at LUISS University in Rome. Originally from Poland, Jakub is bilingual in English and Polish, complementing his international academic and professional skillset.

He has received several awards and scholarships, including the Inner Temple Exhibition Scholarship and the UEA Law School Academic Excellence Scholarship. Outside of law, he is a keen runner and has an interest in comparative law and 20th-century political history.
